



#### Dear Parishioners,

With the month of August upon us, I wanted to share with you the significance of a great Summer feast of the Church. The Dormition of The Theotokos. The Dormition, (κοιμισις) is the commemoration of the falling asleep, of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary. It is the most important feasts dedicated to the virgin.

The feast is preceded by a two weeks' fast, the dormition fast. Sometimes called the "Summer lent" which begins on August 1st and lasts until August 14th. The feast itself is celebrated with a Divine Liturgy on August 15th, which will be held in our church, with the Orthros beginning at 9:00AM. On the weekdays before the Feast, paraklesis services are held in most parishes, as supplication and prayer for her intercessions. The faithful also submit the names of the living to their priests for commemoration. Here at Holy Trinity we will offer a combination of morning and evening paraklesis services, to be sure to accommodate the needs of each of you. May we have her blessing and good strength during the fast!

Besides a rich liturgical life for the month of August, we have also planned a Summer Bible Camp for our youth, from August 1st to the 5th, which will be a joint effort with the Church of Our Saviour in Rye, NY. Children will have the opportunity to learn more about their faith, in a safe and fun atmosphere. Going forward we hope to combine more joint events with our sister parish.

As we look to the fall, and the month of September, we plan to jump in, as Fr. Nick mentioned, full steam ahead! Kicking off our Youth Programs with our Youth and Family Day at Rye Playland on September 1st. I look forward to participating and volunteering in my first Holy Trinity Greek Festival with all of you as well!

#### SUNDAY SCHOOL GUIDELINES

**CLASSES:** Minimum age for enrollment is 3 years and will be placed in our Pre-K class. Children must be 3 by December 15<sup>th</sup> and potty trained. Classes are set up according to grade levels in Public School.

**TERM:** The Sunday School year begins September 25, 2022 and goes to June 18, 2023.






# **Holy Trinity Library**






